It is the policy of the Nursery to ensure that parents/carers have the opportunity to actively participate at all levels, as partners of the organisation and in the planning of services for their children.

We aim for parents/carers to feel comfortable, respected and valued.

The Nursery aims to achieve this by:

- ensuring all parents/carers are made welcome to visit the Nursery at any time and record their views/ideas in a Nursery comments book
- ensuring all parents/carers have access to “Class DoJo”, an electronic record where photographs and comments about a child’s significant achievements are celebrated with families
- ensuring that parents/carers have the opportunity to review their child’s progress as often as requested and on at least one occasion a formal meeting will be arranged between home and the Nursery
- ensuring that parents/carers are involved with the reviewing of policies, procedures and guidelines of the Nursery
- ensuring that parents/carers can meet with staff to discuss relevant issues and concerns
- ensuring that the Nursery values parent’s/carer’s comments regarding the strengths and areas requiring development in the Nursery

Upon request, the Nursery can provide families with a family liaison book. The purpose of this book is to enable parents/carers to exchange information with the Nursery staff.
