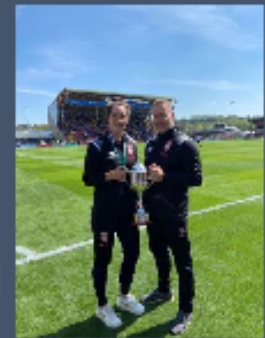

Sunnyside Garden



Everything in the garden is now growing very quickly including the weeds. I try to concentrate on keeping one small section at a time weeded, so that the vegetables can grow unhindered by other plants. It is easier to do this after it has rained as the weeds can then be removed very easily.

This week I planted out the sweetcorn. The runner beans are beginning to grow up their canes and the peas are also growing quickly. These have netting to grow up as they are a very tall variety.

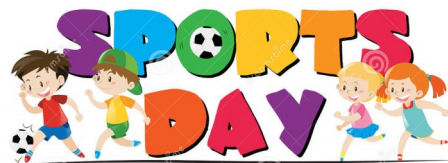
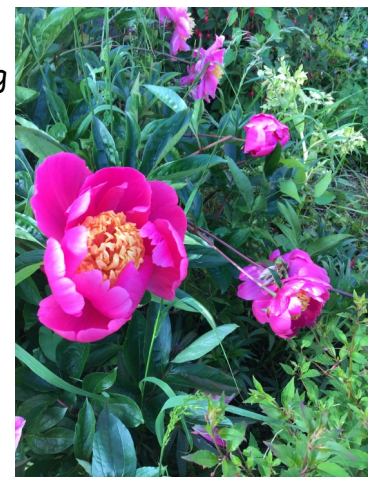


I have experimented this year by planting 3 Tumbling Tom tomatoes in a hanging basket. These plants will produce very small tomatoes. I just have to remember to water and feed them regularly.



My favourite flower at this time of year is the peony. The plant is producing beautiful pink and yellow flowers. I cut off the dyeing flowers so that the new blooms look lovely against the green foliage.
