Firstly, I want to express my gratitude to the entire school community for your ongoing support regarding parking around the school. The safety of our children remains paramount, and the respectful parking habits observed have greatly contributed to this.

While I may sound like a broken record when it comes to attendance, it cannot be overstated how important it is. Our curriculum is designed to build upon prior knowledge, and any missed learning can have repercussions on subsequent learning objectives. I'm pleased to note that the majority of children have attendance rates exceeding 95%, which is commendable and greatly appreciated. As you are aware, starting from Easter onwards, Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) will be issued for holidays, unless under exceptional circumstances. I make no apologies for this stance, as every child has the right to education, and absence from school undermines this fundamental right.

Fixed Penalty Notice

Following a governors' meeting and advice from the Local Authority, St Helena's will start to issue Fixed Penalty Notices with regard to non-school attendance from Tuesday 16th April, 2024.

Non-school attendance includes any day when a child should be in attendance at school and they are absent without the authorisation of the school and it includes unauthorised holidays during term time, persistent absence and persistent late arrival at school beyond the registration period. School starts at 8:50am and registration closes at 9am. Lates will be recorded after this time.

If you wish to seek approval for any request of absence for your child from school, then you must apply in writing to the Headteacher at least 4 weeks in advance of the dates of absence. You should only then remove your child if the absence has been authorised, and notified to you in writing by the school. Any exceptional circumstances must be clearly set out in the written request to the Headteacher who will consider each case upon its merits.

Failure to pay the Fixed Penalty may result in further legal action being taken against you.

Transport information for children starting school in September 2024.

If your child is starting primary school or transferring to secondary school in September 2024 they may be eligible for school transport. If you think your child is eligible please apply for transport as soon as you have your offer of a school place (1 March for secondary school or 17 April for primary). Early transport applications are encouraged to ensure that transport is in place in time for the start of the September term. Applications can be made online at the website below or a telephone application can be made by contacting the Customer Service Centre on 01522 782020.
