You can submit your application online via the **Parent Portal**, which will remain open until approximately **28th January 2025**. After this date, it's best to apply by phone by contacting the admissions team on **01522 782030**.

We encourage you to apply as soon as possible.

## Important information regarding school transport for children starting secondary school or primary school in September 2025



If your child is starting primary school or transferring to secondary school in September 2025, they may be eligible for school transport. If you think your child is eligible, please apply for transport as soon as you have your offer of a school place (3rd March for secondary school or 16th April for primary). Early transport applications are encouraged to ensure that transport is in place in time for the start of the September term. Applications can be made online at the website below or a telephone application can be made by contacting the Customer Service Centre on 01522 782020.






